As a Friend, you will receive advance notification of our programme of events. These occasions provide opportunities to meet and socialise with other Friends as well as enjoying specially selected entertainment.

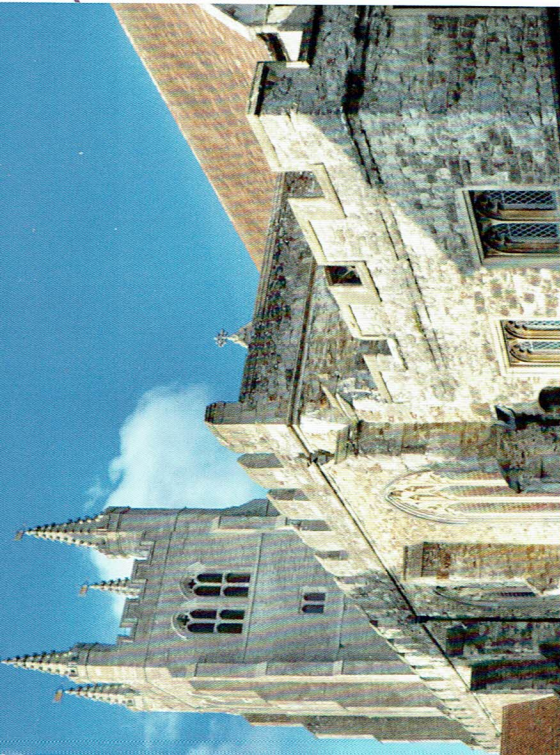

The Friends of St Mildred's was formed in 2014 to raise funds for conservation of the town's beautiful Grade 1 listed parish church which stands at the heart of the Tenterden community.

With origins in the 12th Century, this historic Church building has an ongoing need for repair and restoration to preserve its heritage for future generations.

Since its inception, The Friends have organised a number of high quality musical and other events which, together with subscriptions and donations, have raised over £125K towards the upkeep and preservation of the Church buildings.

Works enabled by The Friends have included repairs to the ancient stonework, to the roof and stained glass windows as well as updating the lightning protection system.
